Marshall Community Credit Union recently learned of a new K9 unit at the Quincy Police Department. After speaking with Officer Hamilton, Quincy Police Officer and K9 handler, it was clear that some necessary items were going to be needed to keep Aries, the newest addition to the police force, safe.

“Officer Hamilton specifically mentioned a bullet proof vest as well as a collapsible travel crate. We ultimately decided to purchase the vest for Aries,” said Becky Hewitt, MCCU Marketing Representative. These vest help protect K9s from from to weapons or other objects, but many units simply do not have the budget to purchase them. In fact, most police dog units are self-funded. “We’re so happy to be able to support Quincy PD, and their new K9 unit,” Hewitt continued.

“Not only does the donated vest help from a financial standpoint,” said Quincy Police Officer, Erin Hamilton, “but it also gives us up to date technology.” Aries will constantly be in situations where he can be harmed. K9 dogs are on duty 24 hours a day performing dangerous work. And vests like the one provided to Aries by MCCU, are lightweight and streamlined. Allowing dogs to remain agile.
