



2022 Scholarship Requirements

Application Deadline is Friday, March 25, 2022

Statement of Scholarship Provisions

The Marshall Community Credit Union Scholarship will provide \$1,000 toward tuition at an accredited college or technical school in the United States. The scholarship will be payable to the college of your choice as a one-time payment for the first semester's tuition, not to include books. Eight scholarships will be awarded in 2022.

Statement of Recipient Requirements

The Marshall Community Credit Union Scholarship requires that the recipient:

- Be a 2022 graduating high school senior
- Be a Marshall Community Credit Union member in good standing
- Attend a college or technical school in the United States
- Provide MCCU proof of college acceptance before receiving funds
- Every qualified candidate will be considered: however, financial need and community involvement will be a factor

Application Requirements

Along with the completed application, student must also include the following:

- Minimum 500-word essay, OR, 30 second-1-minute video, answering the following questions:
 - What have you already learned about money that will help you become a financially strong adult?
 - When it comes to money and finance, what is something you wished you would have learned about in high school that you think would help you in the future?
- Completed media release form
- High school transcript including overall GPA from 9th-12th grade
- Two letters of recommendation from a school counselor, teacher, coach, school leader or employer
- Photo of applicant

2022 Scholarship Video and Essay Criteria

Video Criteria

One of the determining factors in selecting scholarship recipients is the applicant's response to the

topic. The criteria in judging the video will include: **creativity, visual effects, comprehension and expression of the topic.** Make it active, engaging and fun.

Video Guidelines

- Your video should not be more than 1 minute long and not less than 30 seconds. Standard commercial length.
- People appearing in your video or part of the production process will need to sign the attached media release form, individually.
- If you use music, please do not use music or artwork that is protected by copyright.
- Content should be appropriate. Use of foul language, indecent images, etc. will be grounds for immediate disqualification.
- All videos should be posted to YouTube. To submit your video, include the YouTube link in the application. This link needs to be public in order for our review panel to view it.

Essay Criteria

One of the determining factors in selecting scholarship recipients is the applicant's response to the topic. The criteria in judging the essay will be: **organization, language use, originality, clarity, spelling, punctuation, sentence structure, comprehension and express of the topic.**

Essay Guidelines

- Your essay should not be more than 1,500 words and not less than 500 words.
- The essay must be typed, one-inch top, side and bottom margins on each page. Please no title page or headers.

Tips

We want to see you and all the crazy fun talent you've got! Explore ideas and seek information that can demonstrate your knowledge of the topic.

- For essays, challenge yourself to define things, explain things using your knowledge, experience, or research. Show us your personality and dazzle us with your words.
- For videos, we want to see some wickedly talented, fun and creative videos that use images, sound, lights and action to convey the message, the idea, etc. You can do a lot of creative, fun things in 60 seconds. Think about your favorite commercial. What makes you like that commercial? How can you use a similar style for your video?

All applicants are required to complete their own application and write their own essay or produce their own video. A great tip is to start planning ahead today. More time permits more great ideas.

How to Apply

This year we are asking that applicants submit their application, and all required documents, in either paper or electronic format. In addition, please include an appropriate photo that can be used for scholarship award announcements. Please read over guidelines carefully before submitting.

Applications not meeting guidelines or arrive late, will not be considered.

- Application, which includes a media release form, can be mailed to the address below, or saved and submitted in a PDF format.
- Videos can be posted to YouTube and the link put on the application. Please make sure that the link works before you send it. The link needs to be public.
- Photo of applicant can be a physical photograph or saved as a higher resolution jpeg file (300 to 600 dpi).

Complete application/media release, photo and video/essay can be returned to any MCCU location or mailed to the address below.

Applications will be accepted until midnight on Friday, March 25, 2022. However, please plan to submit your application well before the deadline. All entries will become the property of Marshall Community Credit Union.

Scholarship Checklist

Before submitting your application, double check to make sure you have the following included;

Scholarship Application

- The 2022 Scholarship Application has been completed, including the Media Release form.
- I have included my high school transcript including overall GPA from 9th thru 12th grade.
- I have included at least two letters of recommendation.
- I have included a photo of myself (either physical or electronic).

For Essay Submissions:

- My essay contains more than 500 words but less than 1,500 words.
- My essay has been typed, one-inch top, side and bottom margins on each page.
- Yes, there is NO title page or headers.

Video Submissions:

- Everyone in my video has signed a media release form. And I have included all forms in with my application.
- My video is 30 seconds to 60 seconds in length.
- I have not used music that is prohibited by copyright.
- My video has been posted to YouTube and I have included the link in my application.

Helpful Tips:

Please plan ahead. Issues can arise when you least expect it and, especially, when you're trying to meet a deadline. File size could be too large and the email bounces back. You enter an email address incorrectly and we don't receive it. All these things can happen. Don't wait until the last minute.

Send an email to yourself first to determine any issues that might happen before you send the final email. Include your email address in the cc: field when submitting so you can confirm that the email was indeed sent.
