

Marshall Community Credit Union 2023 Scholarship Information

Deadline

Completed applications and all supplemental materials are due on Friday, March 31, 2023. No exceptions!

Statement of Scholarship Provisions

The scholarship will provide \$1,000 toward tuition at an accredited college or technical school in the United States. The scholarship will be payable to the college/technical school of your choice as a one-time payment. Eight scholarships will be awarded in 2023.

Recipient Qualifications

The Marshall Community Credit Union (MCCU) Scholarship requires that the recipient must:

- Be a 2023 graduating high school senior
- Be a MCCU member in good standing
- Attend a college or technical school in the United States
- Provide MCCU proof of college/technical acceptance before receiving funds

Application Requirements

- Complete the "2023 Marshall Community Credit Union Scholarship Application" Form
- Complete the "Media Release Form"
- Complete an essay or video (See 2023 Scholarship Video and Essay Criteria on the next page)
- Provide official high school transcript including overall GPA from 9th -12th grade
- Provide two letters of recommendation from high school staff members or employers
- Provide photo of applicant (electronic version saved as a .jpeg file (300 to 600 dpi))

Please read the 2023 Scholarship Video and Essay Criteria page carefully for further guidelines for essay/video submissions. *Applications not meeting guidelines or that arrive after Friday, March 31, 2023, will not be considered*



2023 Scholarship Video and Essay Criteria

As part of the application process, applicants must complete an essay or video answering the two prompts below.

Scholarship Prompts

- Share what you have already learned about finance that has helped you become a financially strong adult?
- What has been your biggest financial mistake thus far and what have you learned from it?

Video Guidelines

- Ensure your video is at least 30 seconds and no longer than 1 minute
- The criteria for judging the video will include: creativity, visual effects, comprehension and expression of the topic.
- People appearing in your video will need to complete and sign the "Media Release Form"
- Do not use music or artwork that is protected by copyright
- Content should be appropriate
- Use of foul language, indecent images, etc. will be grounds for immediate disqualification
- To submit your video, post to YouTube (publicly) and include the YouTube link in the "2023 Marshall Community Credit Union Scholarship Application" Form

Essay Guidelines

- Ensure your essay is at least 500 and no longer than 1,500 words
- The essay must be typed, one-inch top, side and bottom margins on each page with 12-point font
- The criteria in judging the essay will be: organization, language use, originality, clarity, spelling, punctuation, sentence structure, and comprehension of the topic

All applicants are required to complete their application and write their essay or produce their video without help from outside sources.
