

2018 Scholarship Requirements

Application Deadline is March 31, 2018

Statement of Scholarship Provisions

The Marshall Community Credit Union Scholarship will provide \$1,000 toward tuition at an accredited college or technical school in the United States. The scholarship will be payable to the college of your choice as a one-time payment for the first semester's tuition, not to include books. Eight scholarships will be awarded in 2018.

Statement of Recipient Requirements

The Marshall Community Credit Union Scholarship requires that the recipient:

- Be a 2018 graduating high school senior
- Be a Marshall Community Credit Union member in good standing
- Attend a college or technical school in the United States
- Provide MCCU proof of college acceptance before receiving funds
- Every qualified candidate will be considered: however, financial need and community involvement will be a factor

Additional Information

Along with the completed application, student must also include the following:

- Two, non-family, references
- Minimum 500 word essay answering the following questions:
 - What is one financial lesson you wished you would have learned about in high school, and why?
 - O How would this have helped you better prepare for life after high school?
 - o What is one financial lesson or financial advice you have learned or received?
 - O Why do you feel it was so important to know and who taught it or gave it to you?
- High school transcript including overall GPA from 9th-12th grade
- Two letters of recommendation from a school counselor, teacher, coach, school leader or employer.

MCCU scholarship winners will be announced by April 7, 2018 and in most cases, funds will be paid directly to each winner's school on or about August 31, 2018. Applicant agrees to accept the decisions of MCCU as final. MCCU employees, board members and their immediate family members are not eligible. MCCU reserves the right to disqualify applicants who make any misrepresentations on their application or supporting documents. All applications and supporting documents will be kept confidential, become the property of the credit union and will not be returned.
