### **Cut Your Expenses**

There are many areas where you can cut expenses. Here are a few options to look at if you have a deficiency in your budget, or if you simply want to cut back and save more. To begin, start saving all of your

receipts. At the end of every month, make a list of the the items you purchased. Here are some ideas to help you cut back or eliminate unnecessary monthly spending.



- Cut down your daily coffee purchase to once per week and instead, make it at home.
- Instead of buying snacks from vending machines, gas stations or eating out for lunch, pack a lunch and bring snacks from home.
